

RULES REVIEW – RULE 18

The purpose of rule 18 covers taking relief under penalty of stroke and distance. When a ball is lost outside a penalty area or comes to rest out of bounds, the required progression of playing from the teeing area to the hole is broke; the player must resume that progression by playing a gain from where the previous stroke was made. Rule 18.2 covers off weather the ball is in or out of bounds. The below pictures cover's this rule off well.
