2. We have registered to play in excess of 150 players with 8 minute tee time intervals, PLEASE use ALL Par 3's as play over holes – keep up with the group in front of you, if you can't see the group in front of you maybe you are going too slow, Please play READY GOLF. If your group gets into real trouble please signal to the group behind to play through

3. If you have nominated a golfer, or you have asked someone to play in your place – would you please ensure you either forward the start time email or print it out and give it to your nominated player.

4. COURTESY VAN – there will be a courtesy van available from 4pm through to whenever required. We encourage you to make use of this. As long as the group is large enough the van will go out to Skeet Road and cover streets in Hawera and Normanby. Details of the Driver's phone number will be on the bottom of your information sheet given to you prior to play. A suggestion - to ensure you get to the clubhouse on time it maybe that your can get dropped off and use the courtesy van home.

5. Prize Giving and Social evening will commence at 7pm. This will include Music, Light Supper, Cash draws – six at \$100 (previously \$50) plus a mystery prize. For the cash draws you must not previously have had a draw in any of the previous four cash draws and for both the Cash Draw and Mystery Prize you must be the registered Ticket Holder (no substitutes).
