LADIES PLACEMENT RULE - You may have one club length placement in the general area of the course, (everywhere except teeing grounds, bunkers, penalty areas and greens). You do not have to drop from knee height - this is a placement rule. You may move your ball either way, including onto the fairway if that club length allows you to. This rule is effective from now until further notice. EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE BEING PLAYED: The above placement rule does NOT apply to your club champ qualifying or finals round for club champs' day. If you do use this rule during your match you are disqualified from the club champ's competition. Another exception is if you're playing in a mixed competition, i.e.: 59er's or the Saturday Haggle.

If there are any questions regarding the rule, please feel free to discuss with our appointed referees Julie or Louise, and my ear is also open for discussion.

Next week is Round 1 of the club champ matches play qualifying round - good luck to all the ladies who have put their names forward - the draw will be out later this week so more names are always welcomed. (Go on, give it a go the more ladies entered the better the competition.) Great Golfing to one and all for the week.

#### NEW LOCAL RULE

The Committee have discussed and approved a new Local Rule to be in place from Saturday 29th April 2023, which states:

Relief From Tree Roots: If a player's ball in the 'general area' has interference from tree roots relief without penalty may be taken as Rule 16.1B, within one club length, no closer to the hole <u>But</u> interference does not exist if the tree roots only interfere with the player's stance, or if the roots are within 30cms (2 widths of your printed score card) of the base of the tree. This rule does not apply to the pine tree plantations on the 3rd, 5th, 13th & 14th Holes.

General Area is: Everywhere on the course except Teeing Area, Bunkers, Penalty Areas and Greens. This local rule will be on the board in the foyer and added to the cards when the next batch are printed.
