

May Golf Stats – In May 2024 Te Ngutu members posted 681 rounds which compared with May 2023 of 605, was a 12.6% increase in course usage. During May Ethan Arbuckle played the most golf with 13 rounds, closely followed by Clem Fowler (12) and Ross Cleaver (10). Sandy Shaw with 5 rounds lead the way for our ladies. During the month of May off the white tees for men the 12th hole played the hardest averaging 1.56 strokes over par. Off the yellow tees for the ladies the 14th was the hardest averaging 2.53 strokes over par. For both sets of tees the 11th was playing the easiest.
